The Olympic Stadium was the site for the 1952 Summer Olympics.

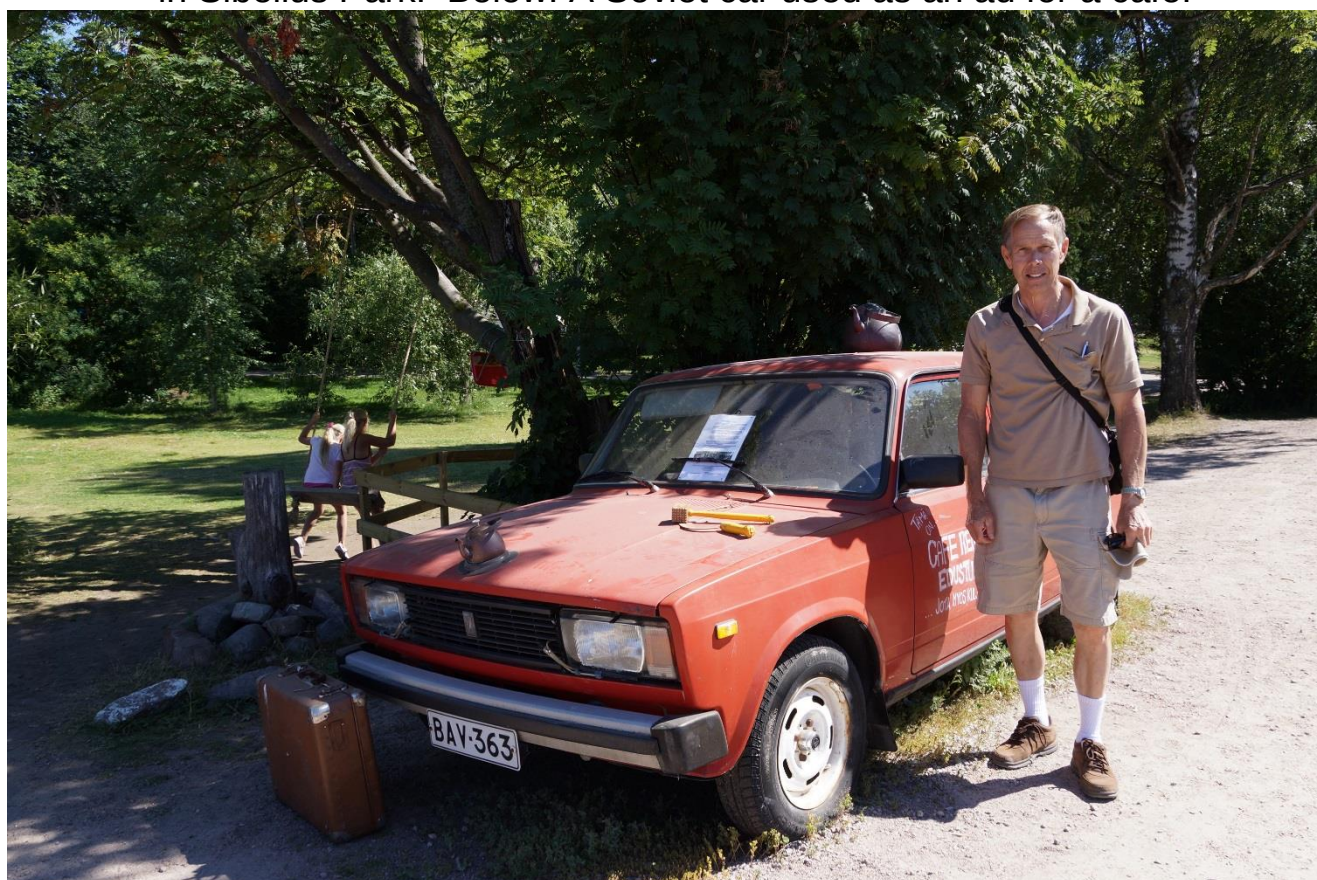




The Olympic Tower is 238 feet high.
