St Mary's Cathedral, also called the Dome Church, is a Lutheran church. It is the oldest church in Estonia with a history back to 1233.

This stone carved sarcophagi is said to contain a lover of Catherine the Great. The female figure on the side is said to be her mourning his loss.



The sarcophagi inscription dates the death at 1788 and mentions Catherine.



A special box above the congregation was made for nobility during the 17th century.
